
## Relationship of Personnel in the Lactation Field

Clinical Lactation Professional	IBCLC - International Board Certified Lactation Consultant.  Frequently referred to as "lactation consultant"	Requirement of 14 college health science courses, 90 hours of lactation-specific education, and 300-1000 supervised clinical practice hours with patients.  Must pass an independent, psychometrically validated board certification exam.	Evidence-based clinical lactation care, education, and support.
